Tuition

Annual Tuition for First Child in a Family	\$5,950
Annual Tuition for Second Child in a Family	\$5,355
Annual Tuition for Third Child in a Family	\$4,820

A child enrolled in preschool is considered the first child for multiple student discounts.

Tuition Payment Options:

Full Tuition Payment

Pay the annual tuition in full by July 1, 2021 in the school office (3% discount will be applied to tuition).

Semester Tuition Payments

Semester payments must be made by July 1, 2021 and January 3, 2022

There is a one-time \$20.00 annual set up fee for this payment option.

Monthly Tuition Payments

Make twelve (12) automatic monthly payments through FACTS Tuition Management. Payments start July 2021 and continue through June 2022. Payments may be processed on the 5th or the 20th of each month. There is a one-time \$50.00 annual set up fee for this payment option.

Students will not be allowed to attend school if an account becomes 30 days in arrears.

There is a \$30.00 charge for electronic and paper returned bank items.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The school's operating expenses are funded through tuition, fees, and gifts from friends of our school. The ongoing support of Restoring Hope Church allows us to provide quality academic programs at affordable rates. Tuition is used primarily to pay employees and cover regular operating costs. Fund-raising is used occasionally for special projects or school groups.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Tuition Assistance is available to all families that apply by May 1st, based upon demonstrated financial need. Requests for tuition assistance must be completed during the Online Enrollment process. The steps necessary to apply for tuition assistance are available in a separate document.

The following policies applies:

1. Financial assistance is available for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade.
2. Assistance is for tuition only. Enrollment, curriculum, late stay, and other fees must be paid in full.
3. Funds are dispersed equitably based on need. Those seeking financial assistance must disclose financial information to the school's designee. RHCA has partnered with FACTS Management to determine financial need.
4. Assistance beyond need verified by FACTS is at the discretion of RHCA and its board members.
5. To apply for financial assistance there is a one time per year charge of \$35.

HEALTH AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Restoring Hope Christian Academy is not financially liable for accidents that may occur at the school. Parents must provide insurance for their children.

ADMISSIONS

Restoring Hope Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

Application Steps

1. Review all printed and digital enrollment material.
2. Tour the school facilities.
3. Apply Online. Go to RHCATN.com and click on Apply Now.
4. Parent/Student meeting with the Head of School.
5. Notice of admission or denial is sent via email.

Student withdrawals require a two-week written notice; tuition is charged during this period.
